Counseling Calendar

Goal: The School Counselor will create and lead various lessons.

Classroom and/or Small Group Lessons are developed within the 3 domains of **Academic, Social/Emotional, and Career Development**

- Kindergarten will see the counselor 11 times.
- Grades 1-3 will see the counselor 12 times.
- Grade 4 will see the counselor 14 times
- Grade 5 will see the counselor 20 times.
- Grades will participate in these lessons as part of their specials rotation each morning.

Career Lessons

Grade 3-5 will participate in Career Day, February 16, 2024.

All grade level participate in Career Guidance Lessons.

Kindergarten will have one Career Lesson.

1st-2nd will have 3 Career Lessons.

3rd will have 4 Career Lessons.

4th will have 5 Career Lessons.

5th had 5 Career Lessons, and a long term Career Project and Presentation.

Social Emotional Development

5th Grade will participate in our Riding the Waves Curriculum which focused on stress management, peer pressure, depression and emotional reactions.

Students learned a variety of stress reduction techniques including;

Journaling

Positive Affirmation and Positive Self-Talk

Progressive Muscle Relaxation

Social Emotional Development

Second Step Curriculum

Social Emotional Learning Lesson (SEL) are provided weekly for all students, Kindergarten-5th grade by their homeroom teachers.

These lessons focus on learning (how to be a good student), empathy, emotional management, and problem solving.

Social Emotional Development

Second Step Curriculum all provides additional curriculum to help reinforce SEL curriculum taught but the teachers:

1. Bully Prevention Unity
2. Child Protection Unit

These units will be taught by the school counselor.

Second Step Curriculum all provides additional curriculum to help reinforce SEL:

Bully Prevention Unity

Focuses on ways to teach students to recognize, report, and refuse bullying!

We also discuss the bully, the victim, and the bystander and how to be a good friend if you see bullying occur.

Social Emotional Development

Second Step Curriculum all provides additional curriculum to help reinforce SEL:

Child Protection Unity

Focuses on teaching students to recognize, report, and refuse unsafe situations, behavior, and safe and unsafe touch.

PBIS Data Review

As the school counselor I will be a leader and coach in the PBIS process to enhance and further solidify the school-wide behavior systems as demonstrated by evidence and artifacts.

PBIS, (**P**ositive **B**ehavioral **I**ntervention & **S**upports) is taught across the school, our acronym is PRIDE.

PBIS expectation lessons are taught in connection with the SEL lessons.

PBIS at RES - PRIDE

This PRIDE vocabulary is taught everyday during classroom instruction and in our common areas such as the cafe, hallway, bus and restroom.
